

Pradeep Guin (PhD, Public Policy, University of Maryland, Baltimore County) is an Associate Professor at the Jindal School of Government and Public Policy (JSGP), O. P. Jindal Global University (JGU), and a Visiting Fellow at the Centre for Social and Economic Progress (formerly Brookings India). His primary area of research lies at the intersection of health, environment and policy. He focuses on studying the impact of climate change on human health and health systems in the context of major climatic shocks, air pollution, vector-borne diseases, and mortality due to extreme temperature. More recently, he has developed a keen interest in studying the politics and governance of pressing environmental problems in India.

At JSGP, he offers courses at the undergraduate and graduate level in the areas of public policy, health policy, environmental health, statistics and econometrics, as well as supervises masters and doctoral-level thesis. His experiences include working with health research and policy organizations in India and the U.S. He has consulted for and collaborated with multiple stakeholders across several governmental, non-governmental, and international organizations responsible for directing policies at different levels. His scholarly work appears in various national and international journals including the Bulletin of the World Health Organization, Environment International, Infectious Diseases of Poverty, SAGE Open, Global Public Health, and Economic and Political Weekly.
