IIHMR Delhi partnered with UNICEF and IIT Bombay to launch the course on Digital Health Enterprise Planning course, a 10-week programme built to bridge the gap between healthcare professionals and new digital technologies.

Healthcare professionals explored a range of topics, from telemedicine and electronic health records to data analytics and artificial intelligence in healthcare. They learned how to leverage digital health technologies to enhance patient care, improve clinical workflows, and optimize healthcare outcomes. Additionally, professionals delve into regulatory and ethical considerations surrounding digital health implementation, ensuring adherence to standards and patient privacy.

The participants were selected based on nominations from state government working in health space or digital health interventions. The criteria encompassed individuals working in the sector with experience of at least 5 years for the test phase. The nominations were also done in Southeast Asia and Africa with participants joining from Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, South Africa.



The course was completed in 10 weeks with live lectures twice a week.
