RATIONALE:-

Hospitals and medical practitioners are faced with making the quantum leap from productivity-based operational models to budgeted care-based business models. In this new era, driving out costs is a critical metric impacting how hospital executives and physicians begin to view and shape the business of revenue and quality deliverables. Conventional containment activities, such as inventory and supply management, are not enough to survive in an era of care- based business models. One of the key challenges to the continued viability of hospitals are developing of relevant and accurate cost information, which forms the pedestal for- strategies, pricing and management decisions. The magnitude of hospital operational costs and inefficiencies in the health system raise questions about the utilization of resources by hospitals.

Cost and cost containment knowledge among healthcare professional and auxiliary professional, will enormously support in setting up competitive low cost – high quality by hospitals. Participants will gain insights and strategies from cost thinkers and practitioners, along with discussion and Case –study pedagogy.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

The core objective of this training program is to imbibe practical cost information to aid managers in effective decision making in terms of procedure, patient and cost behaviours at different managerial levels. Cost- finding and costing tools for analysis can help departmental managers, hospital administrators and policy makers to determine how well organization can meet increasing competitive deliverables for patient care. Analyzing difference in cost containment strategies pre and post pandemic era would also be one of the main agenda of this training program. The basic focus will be on enhancing the technical skills of participants in strategic planning and decision making through cost containment process at various levels in the organization.
